Finance committee report

Finance committee met twice in the last month. Came up with a revised budget based on lower student count. A few more adjustments need to be made to this- need to separate out special education spending/expenses to meet requirements of OW (changes are being made to format of changes requested by OW)

Budget revisions are mainly in areas of staffing, the school's highest cost

Adopt a modified distance learning model- bring high risk students into school one or two days a week, the rest on full distance learning (with google meet classes every day) Adjusting staffing- 4.0 advisor FTE (includes .5 sped) decrease to 3.5 advisors Decrease paras by .5 FTE Decrease food service to 16 hours a week (currently 40), drivers will deliver pre-packaged meals once a week for distance learners Eliminate janitor position

Revised budget to be approved in December Still need to make some adjustments. New budget will show positive bottom line and healthier budget reserve for end of this school year
